

**NOTICE OF MAIL BALLOT PROCEDURES  
TO VOTERS IN CITY OF ROSE CREEK  
MOWER COUNTY, MINNESOTA**

This notice is provided in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 204B.45.

1. Your City has chosen to vote by mail in Federal, State, and Local elections as authorized under Minnesota Statute 204B.45.
2. For 2026 statewide elections, the election dates, and the corresponding dates those ballots will be mailed to all registered voters in the mail ballot precincts are:
  - Statewide Primary Election:** August 11<sup>th</sup>, 2026
  - Ballot Mailing Dates:** June 26<sup>th</sup> – August 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026
  - Statewide General Election:** November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2026
  - Ballot Mailing Dates:** September 18<sup>th</sup> – November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2026

Each voter registered by July 21<sup>st</sup>, 2026, for the Statewide Primary Election, and October 13<sup>th</sup>, 2026, for the Statewide General Election will be mailed a ballot automatically.

3. Eligible voters not pre-registered by the dates noted, or pre-registered voters wishing to receive their ballot at a temporary address may contact the Mower County Auditor-Treasurer office by phone, mail or in person for an absentee ballot application.
4. Voted ballots may be withdrawn up until the end of the business day nineteen days before the election. Please see the Mower County Auditor-Treasurer's office to proceed with this action.
5. All ballots may be returned by mail (a postage prepaid return envelope is included when the ballots are mailed), or may be delivered in person, or delivered by designated agent to:

Ballots must be received no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day in order to be counted. Normal business hours are Monday-Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

6. In addition to the normal business hours, extended hours for mail ballot voting are:
  - Statewide Primary Election:** Saturday, August 8<sup>th</sup>, 2026, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.; Monday, August 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
  - Statewide General Election:** Saturday, October 24<sup>th</sup>, 2026, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.; Tuesday, October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2026, from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.; Saturday, October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.; Sunday, November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.; Monday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2026, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
7. The polling place for this election will be at the Mower County Auditor-Treasurer's office. The polls will be open:
  - Statewide Primary Election:** Tuesday, August 11<sup>th</sup>, 2026, from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
  - Statewide General Election:** Tuesday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2026, from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

At least one assistive voting device will be available at that polling place that permit persons with disabilities to vote privately and independently and that permit any voter to submit their ballot to be automatically checked and corrected for voting errors prior to being cast and counted.

8. All mail ballots will be counted at the Mower County Auditor-Treasurer's office after 8:00 p.m. on the respective election dates.
