Regular Council Meeting June 6, 2022

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof; the regular meeting of the City Council of Rose Creek was held Monday, June 6, with the following present: Mayor Craig Weis, Council Members: Andrew Felten, Bobbie Greenlee, Mark Conradt, Wendel Sprung, Kristine Allas (Clerk/Treasurer), Public Works/Maintenance: Tom Lewison, Bob Jax.

Mayor Weis began the regular Council Meeting at 5:45 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Council Man Conradt made the motion to approve the Minutes from the May 2, 2022, with an addition of "per stump" regarding the trees being taken out at the Wayside City Park for the new playground equipment, council meeting, Council Woman Greenlee seconded, and approved by Mayor Weis.

Council Woman Greenlee made the motion to approve the Agenda, Council Man Sprung seconded, and approved by Mayor Weis.

Dave Whalen requested a building permit for the lot that has the cement foundation/slab of cement, for a single stall steel garage; Council Man Sprung made the motion to approve the building permit, Council Felten seconded, and approved by Mayor Weis.

Isaac Felten, Senior Project: to redo the tennis courts and have a pickleball tournament with entry fee from 8 a.m. – 2 p.m. Saturday of Rose Creek Fun Days. Award money to the top two winners and the rest goes to Rebels (Al Mandt has the paint); age brackets starting at 15 years and up, if the weather is rain, Isaac will reschedule; Council Man Conradt made the motion to approve Isaac Felten's Senior Project, Council Man Sprung seconded, and approve by Mayor Weis.

Denise Lewison is assisting the Special Olympics Friendship Wagon Train as they pass thru Rose Creek; Council Man Sprung made the motion to give \$300 to the Special Olympics from the Gambling Tax account, Council Man Felten seconded and approved by Mayor Weis.

Chief Al Mullenbach explained about the Resolution with Clarey Fire to be able to get better pricing for equipment for the Fire Department; Council Woman Greenlee made the motion to approve the Resolution, Council Man Sprung seconded, and approve by Mayor Weis.

Council Woman Greenlee also made the motion to accept two new firefighters: Michael Johnson and Kyle Mergen to be added to the Department for a total of twenty members as of January 1, 2022, Council Man Conradt seconded, and approved by Mayor Weis.

Nuisance properties: Council Man Conradt made the motion to send the Nuisance Ordinance to the League of MN Cities to get some suggestions, and then after the council decides what they would desire, send it to Attorney Troy Gilchrist after, Council Woman Greenlee seconded, and approved by Mayor Weis. Also question of "can we have the repairs completed on the house to make it presentable, and to require the water be hooked up and finished."

Bleachers/Concrete: Mayor Weis spoke with Dean Bentsen regarding the aluminum bleachers - Mayor Weis to get quotes for cement under the bleachers 4"-5" deep.

Mayor Weis mentioned cleaning of the carpets again, Clerk Allas to contact Arizona Cleaning.

Bob Jax presented a quote for a floor jack and jack stands – Council Man Sprung made the motion to approve the purchase for Bob and Clerk Allas will pay with her City credit card, Council Man Felten seconded and approved by Mayor Weis. Bob Jax is checking into a locator from Adams, and fuel tank for the back of the truck.

Playground: Clerk Allas to send the invoices/expenditures into Mower County for the \$75,000 grant as soon as she has copies of the invoices.

Old Firehall Storage: Tom's personal belongings are gone; Bruce's are still in storage waiting for them to be removed.

Creek Club – Kretta Menuey requested that the City order extra porta potties (2 more) to be delivered to the City Hall parking lot. Creek Club will meet every Wednesday until Rose Creek Fun Days. It will include a parade this year, kiddie carnival in the park, food, and concessions in the park and during youth softball games. 6-7 the 507 Band will play during the Windsor Pork supper, and then head over and play at the Creek Bar & Grill 9:00 – 12:30 pm, softball tournament, Sunday car show, and Clerk Allas to make a map for the city rummage sales. Clerk Allas to order six extra trash cans for a total of twelve with a 4 yard in the park.

Water/Wastewater Fees: the base is \$50.00 per quarter (\$15 water, \$15 wastewater, \$20 surcharge for maintenance. Council Man Conradt made the motion to up the base fee \$25.00 (\$27.50 water, \$27.50 wastewater, \$20 surcharge for maintenance) with a total of \$75.00 for the base fee, Council Woman Greenlee seconded, and approved by Mayor Weis.

Council Man Sprung made the motion to pay all invoices and payroll, Council Man Felten seconded, and approved by Mayor Weis.

Council Man Conradt made the motion to adjourn, Council Man Sprung seconded and approved by Mayor Weis at 7:44 pm with the next meeting to be Tuesday, July 5, 2022, at 5:45 pm.
