AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE DRIED LEAF OPEN BURNING WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ROSE CREEK, MINNESOTA.

The City Council of Rose Creek, Minnesota, ordains:

SECTION I. DRIED LEAF OPEN BURNING.

- Subd. 1. Open Burning of Leaves.
- A. Burning Permitted. Subject to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 88.16, 88.17 and 88.22, the open burning of dried leaves only between September 15 and December 1, is hereby permitted.
  - Limits and Conditions.
  - Such burning shall be limited to the areas of the City zoned for residential purposes only.
  - 2. Burning shall be between the hours of 2:00 P.M. and 9:00 P.M. only.
  - All burning be conducted a minimum of 25 feet from all buildings, structures, and flammable materials, including tall grass and weeds.
    - No person shall burn on public property.
  - 5. No person shall kindle a fire on land of another without first obtaining permission of owner or his agent.
  - 6. No burning is permitted in streets, a person shall be permitted to burn dried leaves on the indrive of property owned or occupied by them. All ashes and other debris must be removed off the indrive after burning.
  - 7. All such fires shall be attended, at all times, by a person of suitable age and discretion.
  - No burning shall take place during an air pollution alert, warning or emergency declared by the Pollution Control Agency and during a fire alert or warning and the Fire Chief may prohibit burning of leaves when atmospheric or local conditions makes such burning hazardous.
- Subd. 2. A copy of this section, or any amendment thereof, shall be submitted to the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency and the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources.

SECTION II. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than Three Hundred Dollars, or imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than ninety days.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its publication.
