## LEGAL NOTICE

Ordinance # <u>70</u> - 1986

ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC, PROVIDING FOR PARKING REGULATIONS DURING SNOW REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL.

The city council of Rose Creek, Minnesota ordains:

Following the falling of 3 inches of snow during any 24 hour period, until all snow removal operations have been ceased, it shall be unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle, or any owner to permit a motor vehicle be parked on any street or public way in the city of Rose Creek between the hours \$:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.

Any motor vehicle found violating the privleges of this Ordinance may be immediately removed and impounded by any police officer or person designated by the council and shall be surrendered only at the duly identified owner thereof and upon payment of the cost of towing operations shall be the responsibility of the owner or operator thereof, and no liability of damages shall be imposed against, nor shall any damage be assumed by the City of Rose Creek.

The removal of the violating vehicles does not preclude prosecution for violation of this Ordinance.

Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be quilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$300.00 or imprisonment for more than 90 days or both. All other ordinances and inconsistent herewith are repealed.

Unless specifically approved by the Director of Public Works, it shall be unlawful to dump or otherwise deposit snow removed from private property

onto public property, meaning streets.

The Director of Public Works may give approval for the depository of snow from filling stations, private parking areas, and similar areas onto public property, providing arrangements can be made for the picking up for such snow by the city crews; in such cases, the benefitting property owners shall reimburse the City for direct and indirect costs of removing snow deposited from private property onto public property.

Any person depositing snow from private property onto public property, including street right - of - ways, shall be quilty of a misdemeanor."
