

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF ROSE CREEK'S ORDINANCE
NO. 73-1987, RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE AND REGULATION.

The City Council of the City of Rose Creek, Mower County, Minnesota, does
ordain:

Subdivision 3. LIABILITY INSURANCE.

Prior to the issuance of a liquor license, the applicant shall file with the
city clerk a liability insurance policy in the the amount of \$250,000 coverage
for one person, and \$300,000 coverage for more than one person and shall comply
with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 340.12 relating to liability
insurance policies. If a liability insurance policy is made subject to all the
conditions of a bond under that statute, the policy may be accepted by the
council in lieu of the bond required under Subdivision 2.

AMMEND TO READ :

Subdivision 3. LIABILITY INSURANCE.

Prior to the issuance of a liquor license, the applicant shall file with the
city clerk a liability insurance policy in the amount of \$50,000 coverage for
one person, and \$100,000 coverage for more than one person and shall comply with
the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 340.12 relating to liability
insurance policies. If a liability insurance policy is made subject to all the
conditions of a bond under that statute, the policy may be accepted by the council
in lieu of the bond required under Subdivision 2.
