

ORDINANCE NO. 49

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE AMERICAN STANDARD FOR THE INSTALLATION OF GAS APPLIANCES AND GAS PIPING CODE, BY REFERENCE.

The Village Council of the Village of Rose Creek, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. GAS APPLIANCE AND GAS PIPING INSTALLATION REGULATIONS.

The American Standard for the Installation of Gas Appliances and Gas Piping Code, as adopted on May 20, 1964 by the National Fire Protection Association, International, and endorsed by the American Standard Association, Inc. on September 18, 1964 one copy of which is on file in the office of the Village Clerk, is hereby adopted as the Gas Appliance and Gas Piping Installation Code of the Village for the purpose of regulating the installation of Gas Appliances and Gas Piping in all buildings and on all land within the Village. Every provision contained in said code is hereby adopted and made a part of this ordinance as if fully set forth herein except the following provisions thereof:

Section 2.6.1.(b) and (c).

SECTION 2. ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTY. The Village Council of Rose Creek, Minnesota shall enforce the provisions of this ordinance. All Gas Appliances or Gas Piping hereinafter installed shall be inspected and if found to be in violation of this ordinance shall be corrected. Written notice stating the corrections to be made shall be served upon the person doing the installation work, and if such person fails or ~~refuses to comply with such notice~~, the Village gas plumbers or any duly appointed inspector may remove the work and charge the cost thereof to the person installing the same. Any person who fails to comply with a correction order, prevents an inspection, or is otherwise guilty of a violation of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$300.00 and by imprisonment for a period not exceeding 90 days.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance becomes effective from and after its passage and publication.
